- Clean up (gather and remove equipment, box up left overs, etc.)

You should wear closed toe shoes, dress for being in a gym, comfortable shoes a must! Lots of standing on a gym floor. These jobs require good eye site and concentration! We do provide t-shirts for our volunteers on a first come, first serve basis.

We provide some drinks and snacks however if you have special diet needs, please bring! Lunch is not served, you may want to pack a small cooler!

There is lots of walking and bending involved with this event however it is indoors!
