## PURPOSE

Wake County Senior Games promotes the health, well-being, and enjoyment of people 50 years of age and older through friendly competitions in sports and the arts.

## WHY SENIOR GAMES

Based on data collected for the Wake County Aging Plan, the population of North Carolina residents age 65 and older is expected to grow 80 percent by 2030. The population 85 and older will grow 50 percent. As a result, by 2030, more than 200,000 people over the age of 65 are expected to be living in Wake County.

The WCSG supports the County's commitment to seniors by offering opportunities for physical activity and social interaction.

The benefits of regular, competitive exercise for seniors include:

- Disease prevention and management
- Improvement in mood
- Social interaction with peers
- Opportunity to compete in sports they enjoy

The WCSG encourages seniors to engage in regular exercise, improve athletic abilities, explore artistic creativity and create a social network with other seniors who share their interests.

As the senior population in Wake County continues to grow, WCSG will play a significant role in supporting the county's commitment to providing opportunities for the county's senior population to remain active and improve overall health.

## SENIOR GAMES EVENTS

The 2019 Wake County Senior Games will be held primarily throughout the month of April across Wake County. The Senior Games, one of 53 sanctioned by the North Carolina Senior Games, hosts athletes and artists and is one of the largest in the state.

In 2018 more than 500 people from ages 50 to 99 participated in more than 50 individual and team events. The top medalists in each event, by age and gender, are eligible to compete in the North Carolina Senior Games each fall.

In addition, the Senior Games includes 35 SilverArts competitions in literary, heritage, visual and performing arts.
